REW istanbul will once again provide companies and businesses the opportunity to network and further grow their business under the one roof...




## REW İSTANBUL More International Every Year

In 2009, companies from 18 different countries were represented and the total number of exhibitors increased by 13%. International visitor counted for more than 10% of the total number visitors being 8376 professionals & decision-makers.

## REW ISTANBUL jazzed up by the on - going activities!

Turkey's 13 leading municipality officials had the chance to share their decisiveness regarding climate change with the public through the signature ceremony for the document of intention included in the project "Cities for Climate Protection Campaign" which was introduced in our country by REC.

The Schedule programme with its focus on environmental problems of OIZs and the possible recommended solutions was organized in cooperation with the Higher Institution of Organized Industrial Zones (OSBUK).



In the programme jointly organized with Recyclable Packing Material Collectors and Separators Association (TUDAM), the current situation for Packing Waste was discussed and clarified. This programme, which has significantly drawn Turkish industrialists was also keenly followed by local administrative boards.

Gebze Institute of Technology conducted a meeting regarding the use of membrane system in waste water treatment and energy generation out of biological waste with attendance of authorities from the industry.

During the exhibition, Istanbul University and Gebze Institute of Technology organized continuous programmes in their booths for four days which received high-level interest.

TUBITAK, ISO & KOSGEB conducted briefings about Co-opertion Possibilities with European Union - EU Departments - EU Funds and European Commercial Companies, both in seminar halls and in their own booths during the exhibition.
